



Alan Kalter, for the last 15 years, has been Dave's "announcer" on "[Late Show with David Letterman](#)", known on-camera as "Big Red". His comedic sketches include "The Kalter Twins", "Alan Kalter's Celebrity Interview", "Where Are They Now?", "For the Ladies", "You're Busted" and "Alan Makes Your Product Sound Sexy". He's been seen wearing an Elvis-style sequined jumpsuit, Olympic Ice Skater tights or almost nothing at all.

After a decade of radio at WTFM and WHN in NYC, Alan was the voice of [USA Network](#) throughout the '80s, the announcer for a number of [New York](#)-based TV gameshows, "ABC's College Football", "Wide World of Sports" and "20/20" and continues to do voiceovers for radio and television commercials. He was the Principal on the TV show "Ed", and you've seen him selling cars, advocating colonoscopies and tossing melons for a series of TV spots for New York Lottery's Mega Millions.
